Here's how.

- STEP 2: Find a location for your sale. Depending on how you plan to run your sale, this could be someplace as small as a church or school hallway – or as large as a gymnasium. You decide.
- STEP 3: Determine how much you will charge for your items. Remember, you want to make a profit. Pricing the goods in whole dollars will eliminate the need to have lots of coins on hand.
- STEP 4: Promote your sale. We've made it easy by providing posters you can print and post. You'll also want to send a news release to your local newspapers, TV and radio stations. Post the information on your Facebook and Twitter pages, too!
- STEP 5: Collect the money you raise and send a check to: SCC HD Scholarship Fund.
